

Multiple Intelligences Theory: A brief explanation

Howard Gardner, Ph.D., Professor of Education at Harvard University, developed a world-renowned theory about human potential. His theory claims that there are 8 different types of intelligences (or competences). Each person has a unique blend of intelligences. And each kind of intelligence is related to different jobs/positions in our society. In the labour market, and in life in general, we need people who are good at different things. A good career decision is where a person chooses a career pathway where they can take advantage of their most prominent intelligences.
